Dear Participant,

Please take a moment to read the following important information:

# 1. Behavior During the Competition:

- raffic Regulations:\*\* Traffic regulations apply throughout the marathon.
- Safety Each participant is responsible for their own safety. Marshals and helpers must be obeyed.
- Overtaking: Faster riders must be allowed to overtake at any time. "Overtakers" must ensure that slower riders are not endangered.
- Course Shortcuts: Cutting the course or leaving the course will result in immediate disqualification. There is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.

#### 2. Disclaimer:

- Legal Claims: Each participant agrees to waive all legal claims against the organizer or host and their helpers or agents.
- Fitness and Health: Participants declare that their training and health condition meet the demands of the competition.
- Liability: The organizer assumes no liability for the loss or damage of valuables.
- Consent: By registering, each participant agrees to the terms on the website [www.hegaugravel.de](http://www.hegaugravel.de).

# 3. Bib Number Pick-up - Opening Hours:

The bib number pick-up is open at the following times:

- Saturday, June 29, 2024: 4:30 PM 6:00 PM
- Sunday, June 30, 2024: From 7:00 AM until 30 minutes before the respective start

# 4. Emergencies:

- Assistance: Participants are obligated to provide assistance in emergencies.
- Emergency Services: A race doctor is available at the start and finish area and on the course. They can quickly reach the accident site with the help of a quad. The DRK Singen is also on the course. **Emergency number: 112**
- Mobile Phone: Please carry a mobile phone during the race.

#### 5. FEED & TECH ZONES:

- On-Course: Two refreshment stations (Feedzones) per round on the course and one at the finish. They offer water (carbonated and still), apple spritzer, Nutrixxion bars, muesli bars, cake, bananas, and gels.
- Technical Support: Technical support is allowed on the course.

#### 6. Time Limit:

- <del>136 km 106 KM</del> Course There is a time limit. From 3:30 PM, it is no longer possible to start the nex lap. Affected participants will be officially recorded with their time up to that point. The time limit does not affect the World Championship qualification.

# 7. Transponder / Certificates / Finisher Gift:

- Timekeeping: Timekeeping is done by "Race Result Germany" using a transponder embedded in the bib number. It is a disposable transponder that does not need to be returned
- Certificates Available online from Monday, July 1, 2024.
- Finisher Gift: Distributed in advance during the bib number pick-up. Finisher medals will be given out at the finish area.

#### 8. Bib Numbers:

- Handlebar Number: Assigned colors based on the chosen course (black = 106 km, red = 54 km, blue = 54 km, green = 32 km).
- Back Numbers: Issued for the 106 / 56 KM courses according to age groups. Wearing the back number is mandatory in these races.

## 9. Starting Procedure:

Race Order / Block Division:

- Race 1: TREK UCI GRAVEL WORLD SERIES: 136 km 106 KM Start at 10:10 AM
- \*\*Priority Box 1:\*\* Only riders with an Elite/Pro license (25 riders selected by the organizer)
- \*\*Priority Box 2:\*\* Additional Elite/Pro license riders (not selected for Box 1)
- \*\*Age Groups:\*\* 19 34 (Men & Women), 35 39 (Men & Women), 40 44 (Men & Women), 45 49 (Men) & 45 and older (Women), 50 54 (Men), 55 and older (Men)

# Race 2: TREK UCI GRAVEL WORLD SERIES SCHWÖRERHAUS HEGAU GRAVEL 54 km - Start at 10:40 AM

- \*\*Age Groups:\*\* 19 – 34 (Men & Women), 35 – 39 (Men & Women), 40 – 44 (Men & Women), 45 – 49 (Men & Women), 50 – 54 (Men), 55 – 59 (Men), 50 and older (Women), 60 and older (Men)

Start Boxes:Marked by color (see back number). Each participant is assigned a start block in their age group. Participants must start from their designated start block. Starting from a block of a younger age group will result in disqualification. Participants must be in their start block at least 15 minutes before the race starts. Follow the marked entrances. There is no ranking order within a start block. Participants who arrive first should line up at the front to allow others to fill in and keep the entrance area clear. It is not allowed to enter the start block by jumping over barriers or pushing in.

Start SignalThe start will be signaled by a start shot, with age groups starting at approximately 1-minute intervals.

#### Race 3:

# 1.DM Ärzte und Apotheker SCHWÖRERHAUS HEGAUGRAVEL 54 km\*\* - Start at 10:40 AM

### Race 4:SCHWÖRERHAUS HEGAUGRAVEL 32 km - Start at 10:55 AM

- The start is in a separate start block. No class division.
- The start is signaled by a start shot.

#### 10. Course Division:

- Before Duchtlingen: The course splits into a large round (54 km) and a small round (32 km). The split is marked here's an overview:
  - 136 km 106 KM: 2x large round, then 1x small round
- 54 km: 1x large round
- 32 km: 1x small round
- Responsibility: Each participant is responsible for following the correct, registered course.

### 11. Race Abandonment / Bad Weather:

- Force Majeure: In the event of higher forces (e.g., bad weather), the organizer reserves the right to cancel the race for participant safety. Participants will be directed off the course by the nearest marshal and are responsible for their own safety. Seek shelter in built-up areas. There is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.
- Weather Impact:Due to a storm in the Hegau region on June 26, 2024, there may be short-term course changes or adjustments.

#### 12. Finish Line:

Team HegauGravel\*\*

- Town Hall Square: The finish for all courses is on the town hall square.
- Course Departure Participants of the 32 km and 54 km courses must leave the course immediately after finishing, while participants of <del>136 km-106 KM</del> courses continue their next lap. Drive carefully to avoid accidents when exiting.

# 13. Showers, Changing Rooms, Bike Wash:

- Münchenried Sports Hall:Showers and changing rooms are available at Münchenried Sports Hall (Münchriedstr. 6, 78224 Singen), about 1 mile from the start & finish area. The route is signposted. A bike wash station is available at the start & finish area.
